- February 15** Begin accepting applications for admission to summer 2017.
- April 10** Registration by appointment begins for CalWorks, EOPS, DSS, Foster Youth, and eligible veterans - online registration only.*
- April 12** Registration by appointment begins for continuing students (enrolled in summer 2016, fall 2016, or spring 2017), online only. Check Insite/WebAdvisor for your specific appointment day and time.*
- April 19** Registration begins for new matriculated and returning students online only.* Returning students who missed more than one year need to reapply.
- May 8** Registration by appointment begins for new non-matriculated students, online only.*
- May 29** **Holiday - Memorial Day - college closed**
- May 30** **Three-week summer session begins (May 30- June 16)**
- May 30** **Nine-week summer session begins (May 30- July 27)**
- May 30** Late enrollment - space available basis. Use online registration with late add code, or in-person signature of instructor or late-add code.**
- May 30** AA/AS degree or certificate filing period begins through July 27.
- May 31** Begin new and returning special admit/concurrent high school students registration grades 11 and 12.
- June 1** Open walk-in registration for all students
- June 19** **Six-week summer session begins (June 19 - July 27)**
- June 19** Late enrollment - space available basis. Use online registration with late add code, or in-person with signature of instructor or late add code. **
- July 4** **Holiday (observed) - Independence Day - college closed**
- July 27** Deadline to file AA/AS degree or certificate
- July 27** Last day of summer session
- August 11** **Fall classes begin (weekend classes begin August 12)**

Final exams: are scheduled by the instructors and are generally held on the last day of instruction.

Registration for classes after the course begins is on a space-available basis and will require a late add code or instructor signature. Students may use a late add code to register online. Students must register at the admissions counter with an instructor signature. Insite/WebAdvisor registration is available daily up to midnight the day before the class section begins.

* Online registration is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Students may register anytime on or after their appointment date and time up until midnight the day before the class section begins.

** Summer term class add/drop, refund, and pass/no-pass dates are calculated individually by class based on the specific number of meeting days. The add/drop and refund dates are listed on the class roster. Check with the instructor. You may also go to Insite/WebAdvisor, registration, to "My Class Schedule" for drop and refund dates. The dates are listed under the "Last Date to Drop" column.

Reminder: To receive a refund for a summer course, students must drop the course within 10 percent of the total class meetings, which in most cases, during the summer, is the first class meeting.
