PROGRAM INCLUDES

- Housing in fully furnished apartments in central Barcelona. A homestay option is available for a supplemental fee.
- Travel pass for use on buses and the metro in the central zone.
- Study Center with free wireless Internet access.
- Low-cost cultural program including such events as cooking classes, sporting events, walking tours, theater and dance performances, tapas evenings and day trips.
- Articket pass providing one free entry to each of six museums in Barcelona.
- Support services, medical insurance, travel arrangements and student advisors provided by AIFS.
- Optional Transportation Package (SFO-Barcelona-SFO) including round-trip airport transfers in Barcelona.
