

Assessment Check List

Coming in to take an assessment test? Great! For a smooth process please remember the following:

- Double-check our testing schedule and office hours. These are available on our website at www.dvc.edu/assessment or on the door of the assessment center.
- Remember to bring your photo ID (driver's license, student ID card, passport, etc.) and know your DVC student ID number. Both are required to take any test or to pick up scores.
- Most tests are approximately 1 hour in length and you may not leave once the test has begun. Make sure you are feeling alert, healthy, and have stopped off at the restroom prior to beginning the test. Only come in when you are feeling ready and prepared to take the test.
- Taking the math assessment test? Be sure to review for the test using the sample questions provided on our website. These will help you to determine which test to take in order to place you into the most appropriate class.
- Taking the English assessment test? The test is in two parts, so you will need to practice both your reading comprehension as well as your essay writing skills. Be sure to review for the test using the sample questions provided on our website.
- Taking the Chemistry assessment test? Looking for a study guide? Try reviewing the course contents of Chemistry 108 and/or your high school Chemistry text book.

There are limits to the number of times that you can take these tests. Please be prepared before coming in!
