Advanced Technology Center (ATC)

The Advanced Technology Center (ATC) opened fall semester, 2006. The ATC—former Life Science building—consists of six computer labs, two wireless lecture labs and one video-conferencing lab (planning stages). On a *priority scheduling basis*, the ATC is a college resource for supervised computer labs, new programs, class reservations, online orientations, staff development and student service activities. Requests for ATC classrooms are made through the schedulers in the Instruction Office. Requests for keys are made through the normal process.
