Previous Minute Approval: March 1, 2018 minutes were approved.

Membership:

Lisa reported that the membership on the committee should include members who attend or conduct department or area related meetings at which decisions are made. There are only two people staffing Assessment; they cannot afford to release someone to attend Dev. Ed. meetings. Lisa reached out to Stephanie Alves and will follow up on recruiting a member from A&R.

IP Meeting Report Out:

Those who attended the meeting summarized their experience. The consensus was that the meeting fostered a constructive dialogue, and that it was informative to see the demo of the new assessment tool. There was also the reflection that the Integrated Plans goals 2 and 3 may need to be updated given AB705 and the recommendation to increase the probability that students complete transfer level math and English classes in one year.

Project Proposals/Updates:

- DSS Project – it still needs work, Katy observed that it could be redundant given that English has SIs in developmental classes, we need to meet with David to continue the discussion on this project
- Math Leap – approved
