Experimental Courses – effective spring 2021
PSYCH-155J Psychology of the Human-Animal Bond
Carmen McNeil and several members of the Psychology department were present to clarify the proposed course. McNeil noted that there is a large student interest in this course. Parts of the content of this course have been introduced in McNeil's other courses and students have required a deeper dive into the subject. She added that it is a timely course due to COVID-19 and the increase in the adoption of animals. This course will count as elective units but currently the department has no plans to make it a permanent course. Pham met with the department to clarify transfer implications and further confirmed that this course will be transferable as elective units only. The committee recommended that the experimental course form be revised to note the implications of offering general education type courses as experimentals.
