They are testing different types of features in eLumen as well attending a webinar on assessment next week. Moultrie is also meeting with a representative from eLumen to go over more of the assessment features that we have not yet explored. The goal has always been to be able to gather the high quality of information from eLumen that we easily got from WebSLOs.
