STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES COMMITTEE**

CHARGE/FUNCTION:

- To encourage and coordinate faculty efforts and initiatives regarding student learning outcomes in instructional areas.
- To serve as a resource to faculty in developing and implementing student learning outcomes.

DUTIES:

- To **oversee** process in the institutionalization of the student learning outcomes cycle
- To have one member serve as a liaison to the College-wide Student Learning Outcomes Committee

MEMBERSHIP:

Chair: Full-time faculty member from the committee members appointed by the DVC Academic Senate President and approved by the Academic Senate Council

5-7 Faculty (at least one from a vocational education area—overlap with Program Review Committee would be desirable: PT faculty desirable)

1 Student appointed from ASDVC

A. VOTING:

All faculty members and the student representative on the committee may cast a vote.

Ex-officio members are non-voting members. In the case of co-representatives, only one (1)

representative vote will be allowed. The chair may vote only to break a tie. Actions will pass with a 2/3 majority vote.
