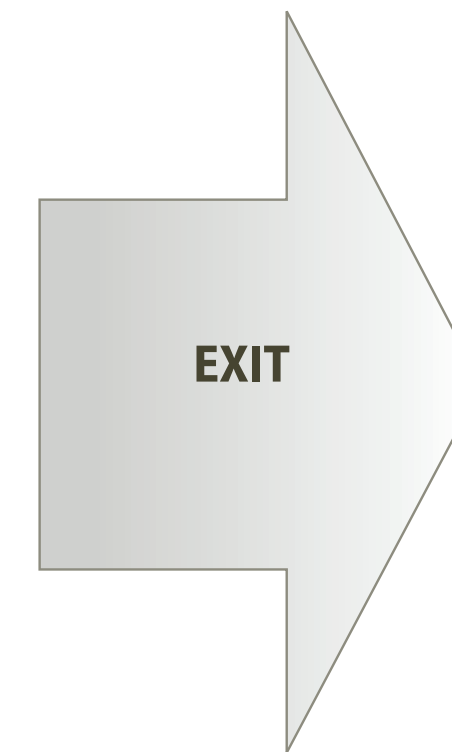
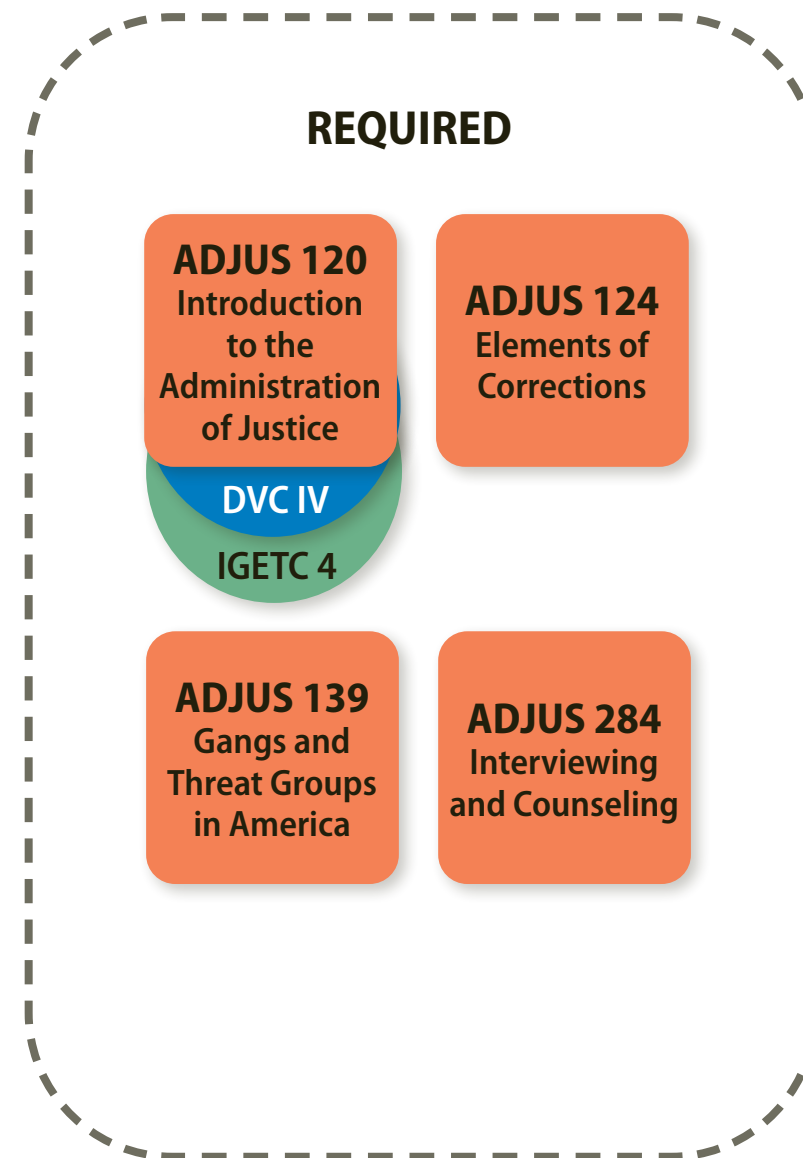
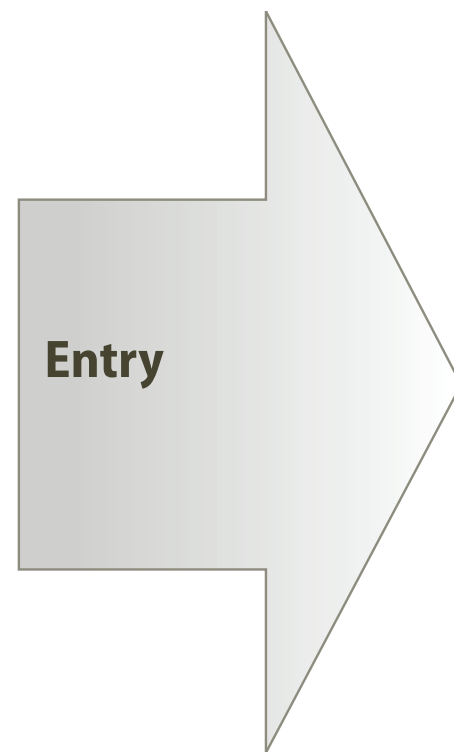

Students completing this program will be able to:

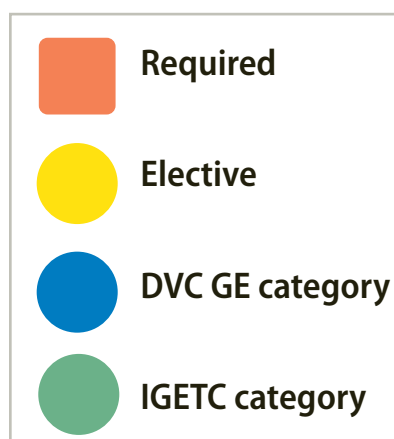
1. Demonstrate familiarity with the basic components of the criminal justice system with special emphasis on the correctional system.
