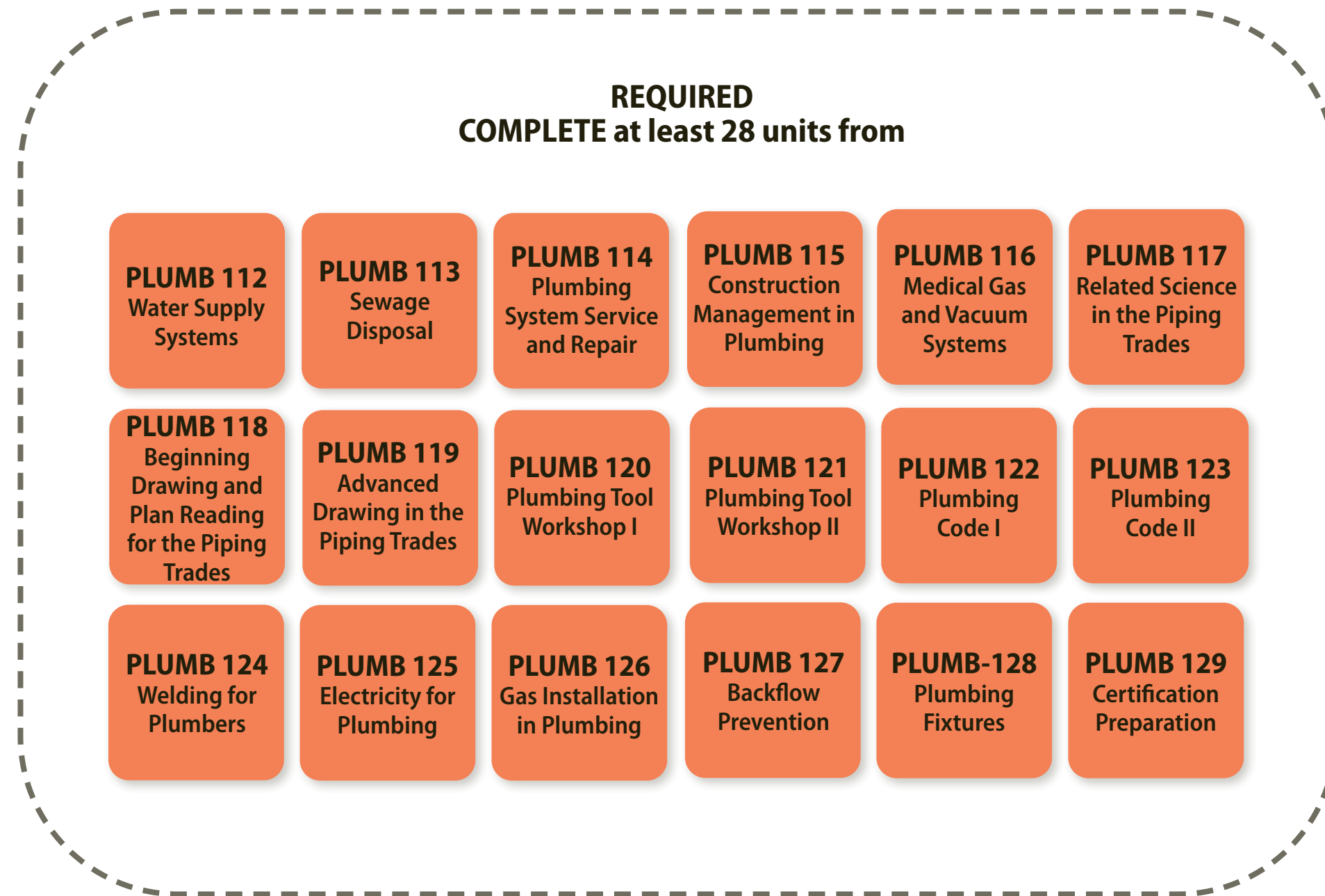


Plumbing Certificate of Achievement
