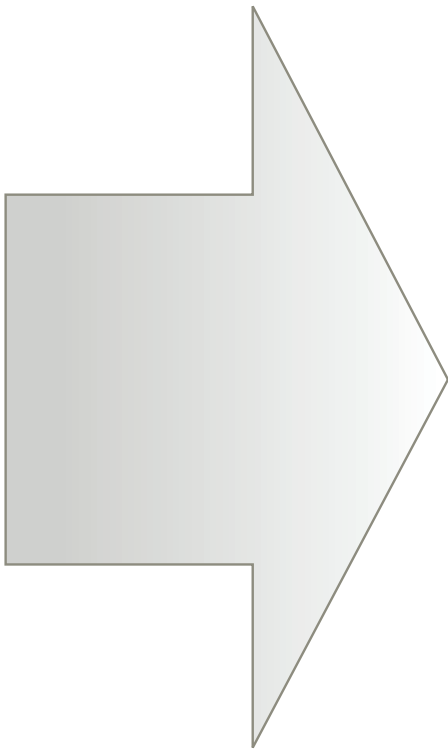
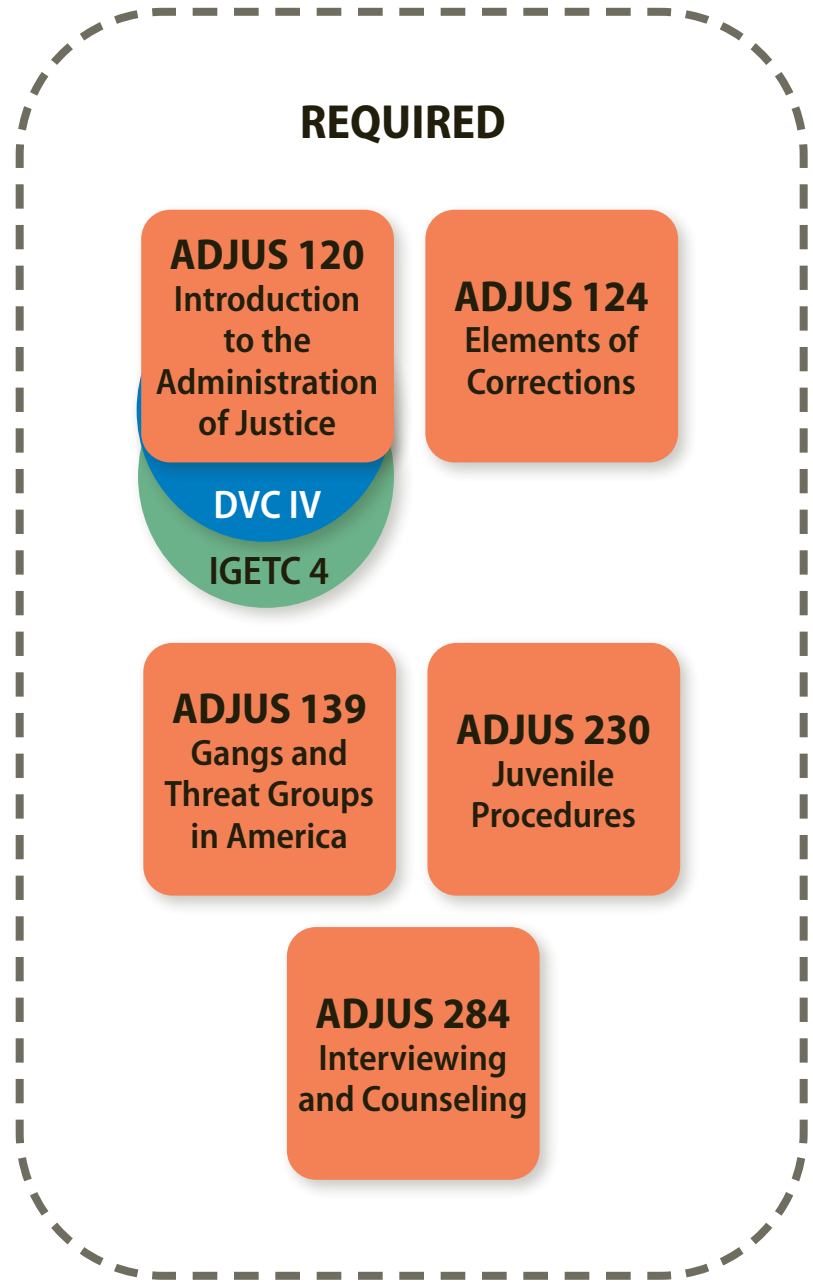
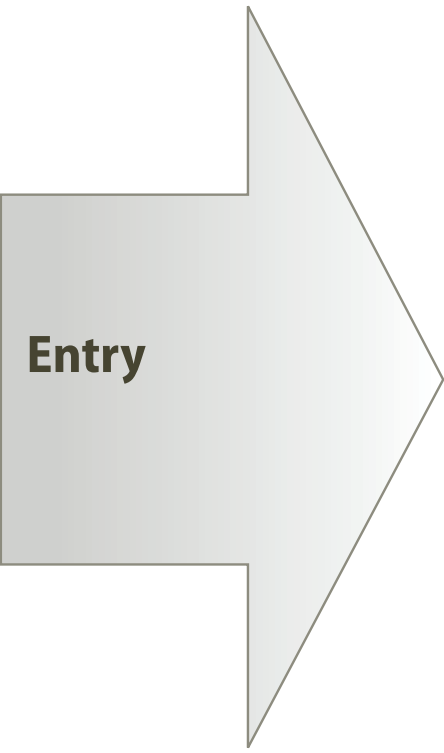


Administration of Justice Juvenile Counseling Certificate of Accomplishment
