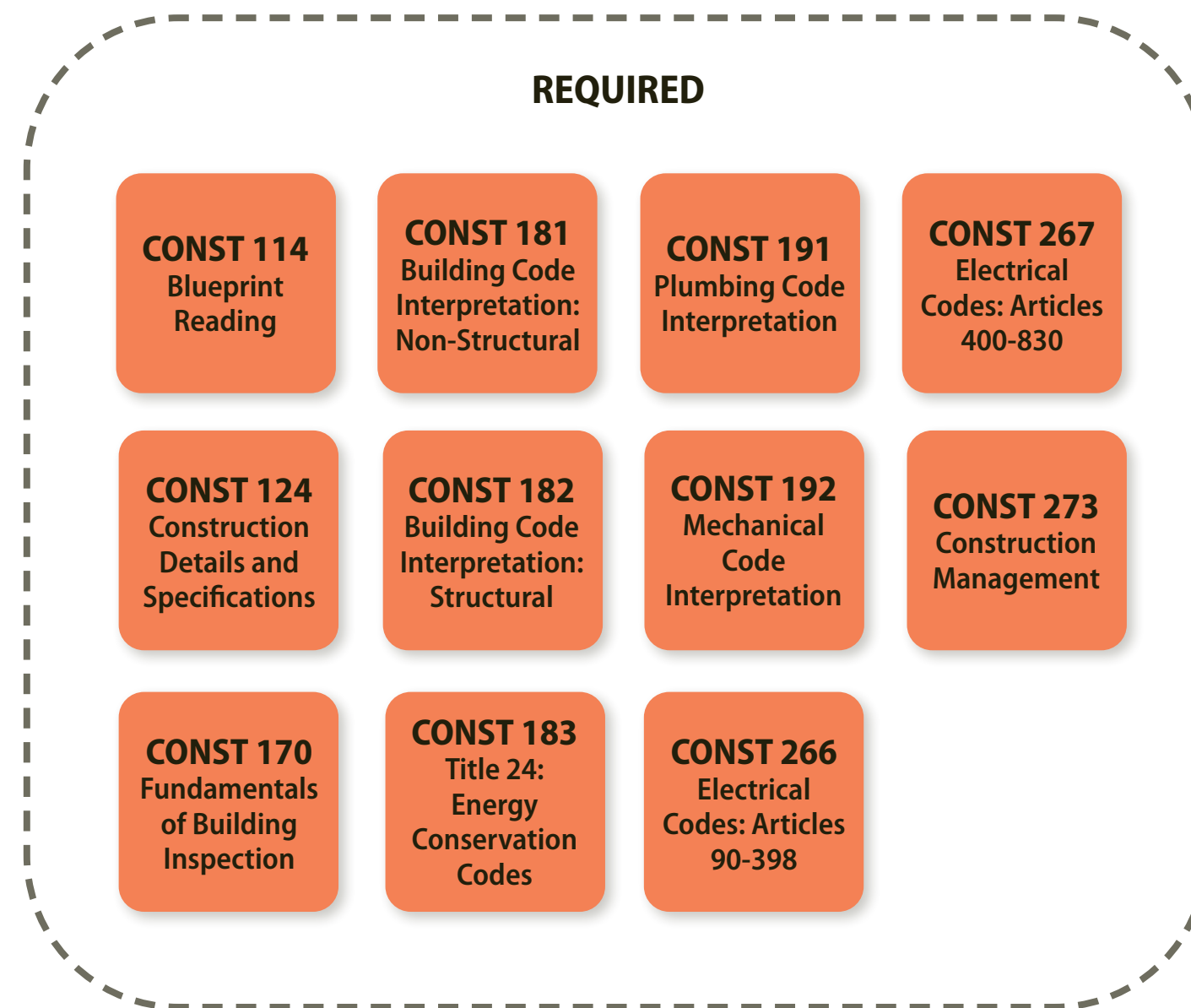
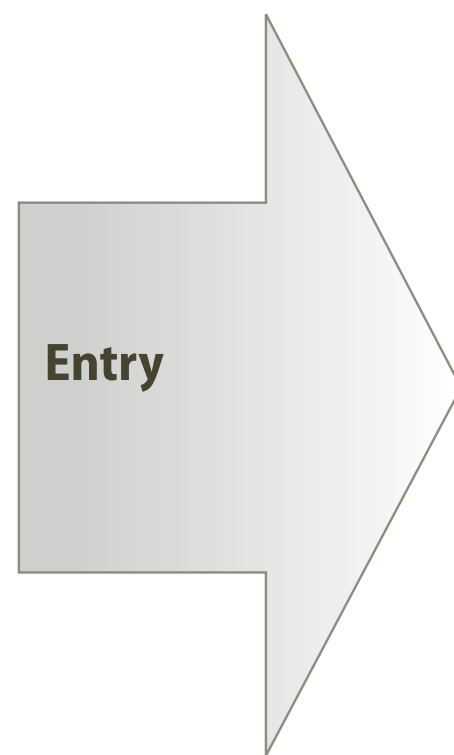

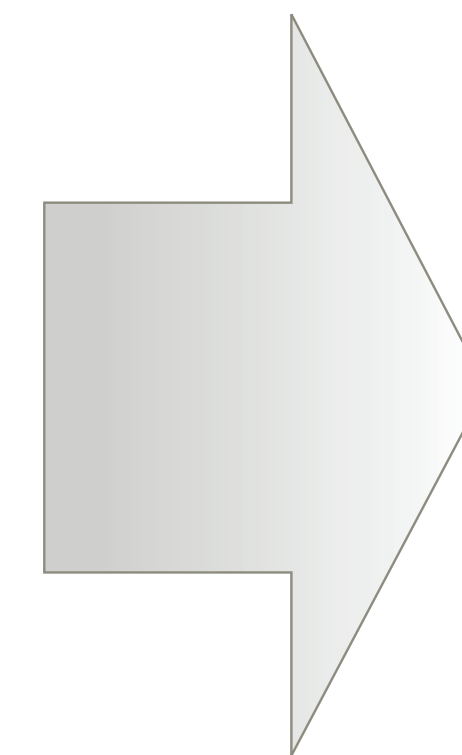
PROGRAM LEARNING OUTCOMES

7. Interpret blueprints and specifications.

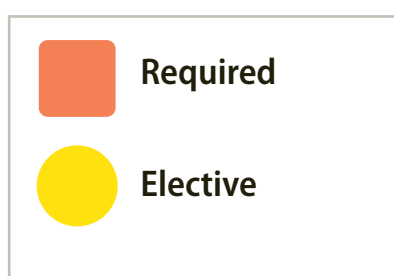
