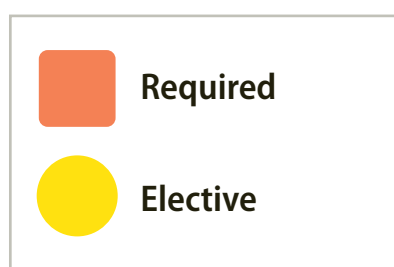
- Students completing the program will be able to:
