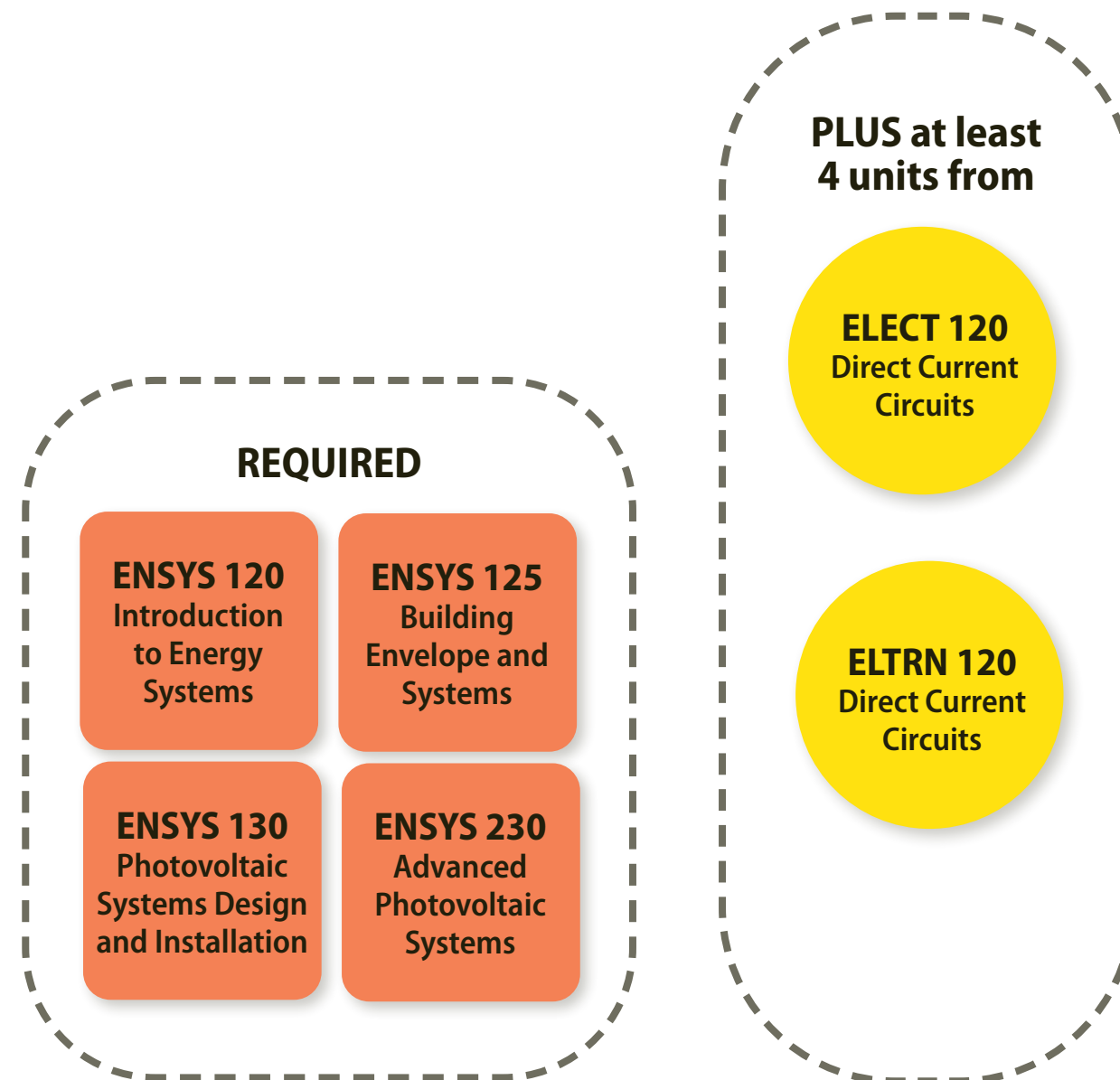
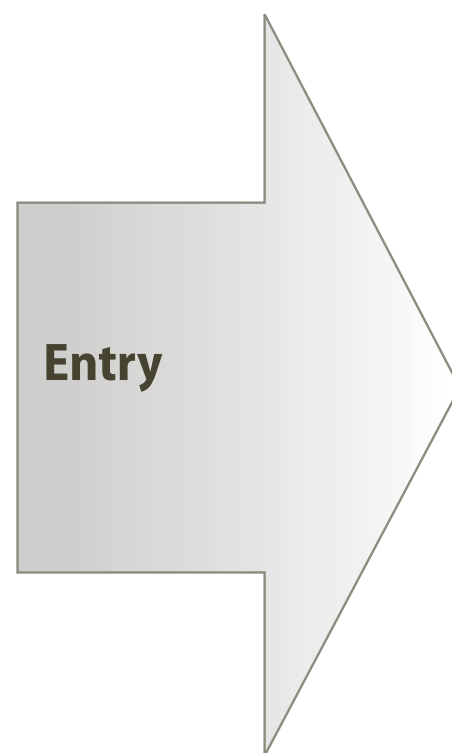


# ENSYS Energy Systems Certificate of Accomplishment

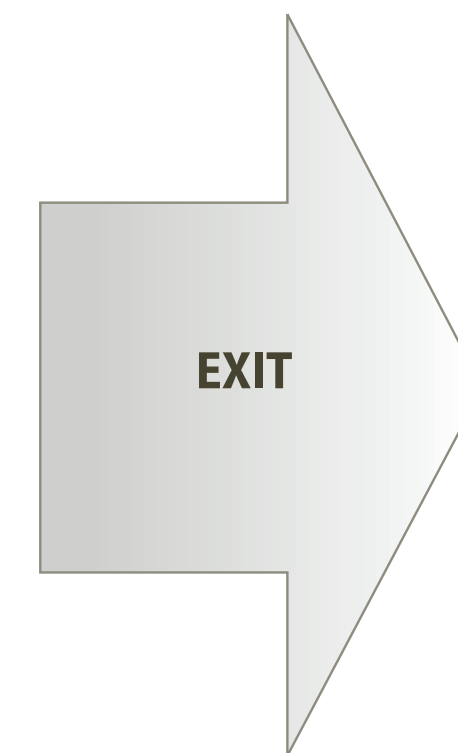
## PROGRAM LEARNING OUTCOMES

3. Design medium complexity solar photovoltaic or other energy system for medium size commercial buildings and processes.

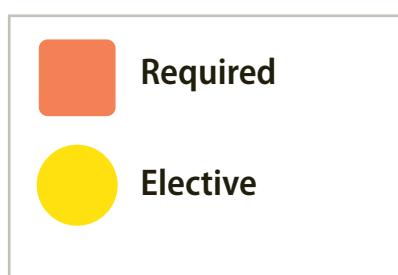
