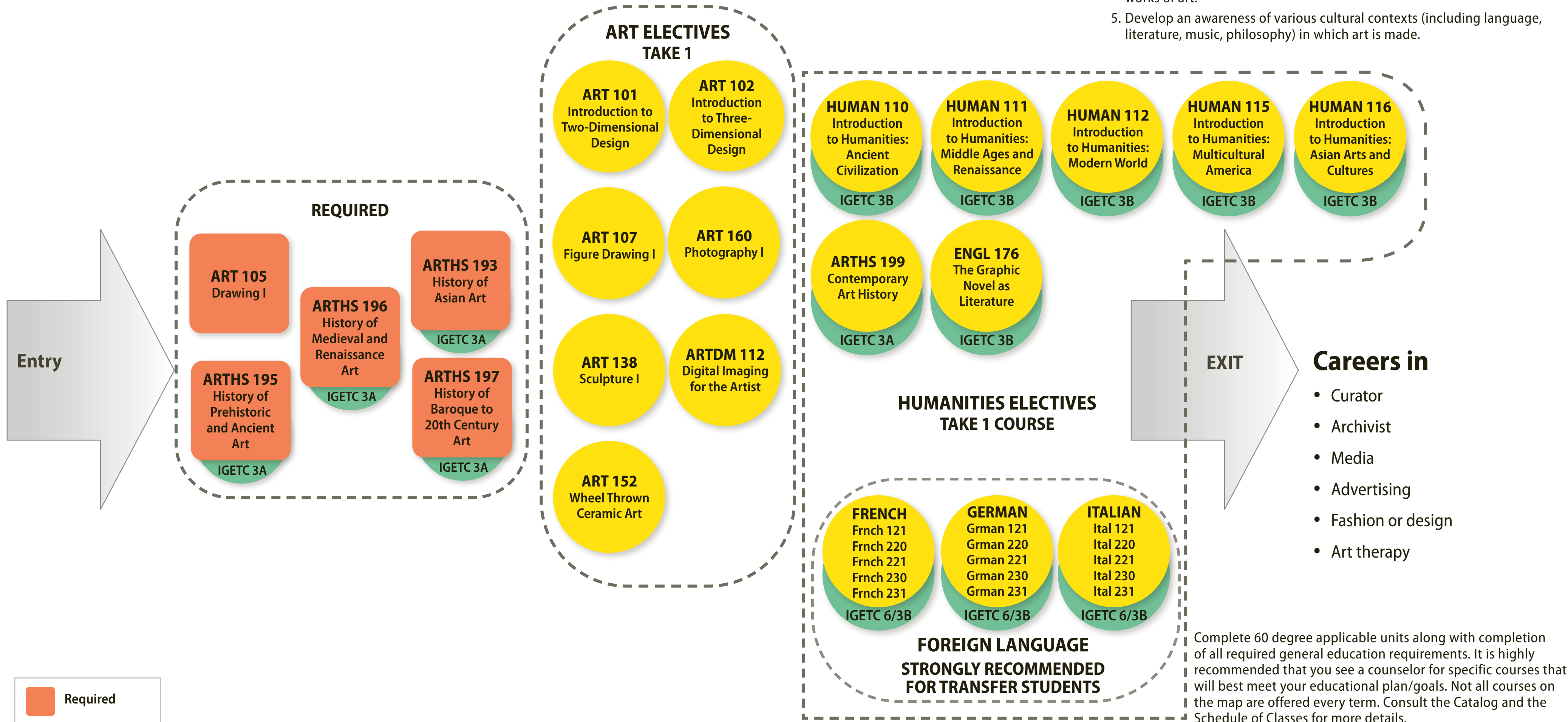


# Art History AA-T
