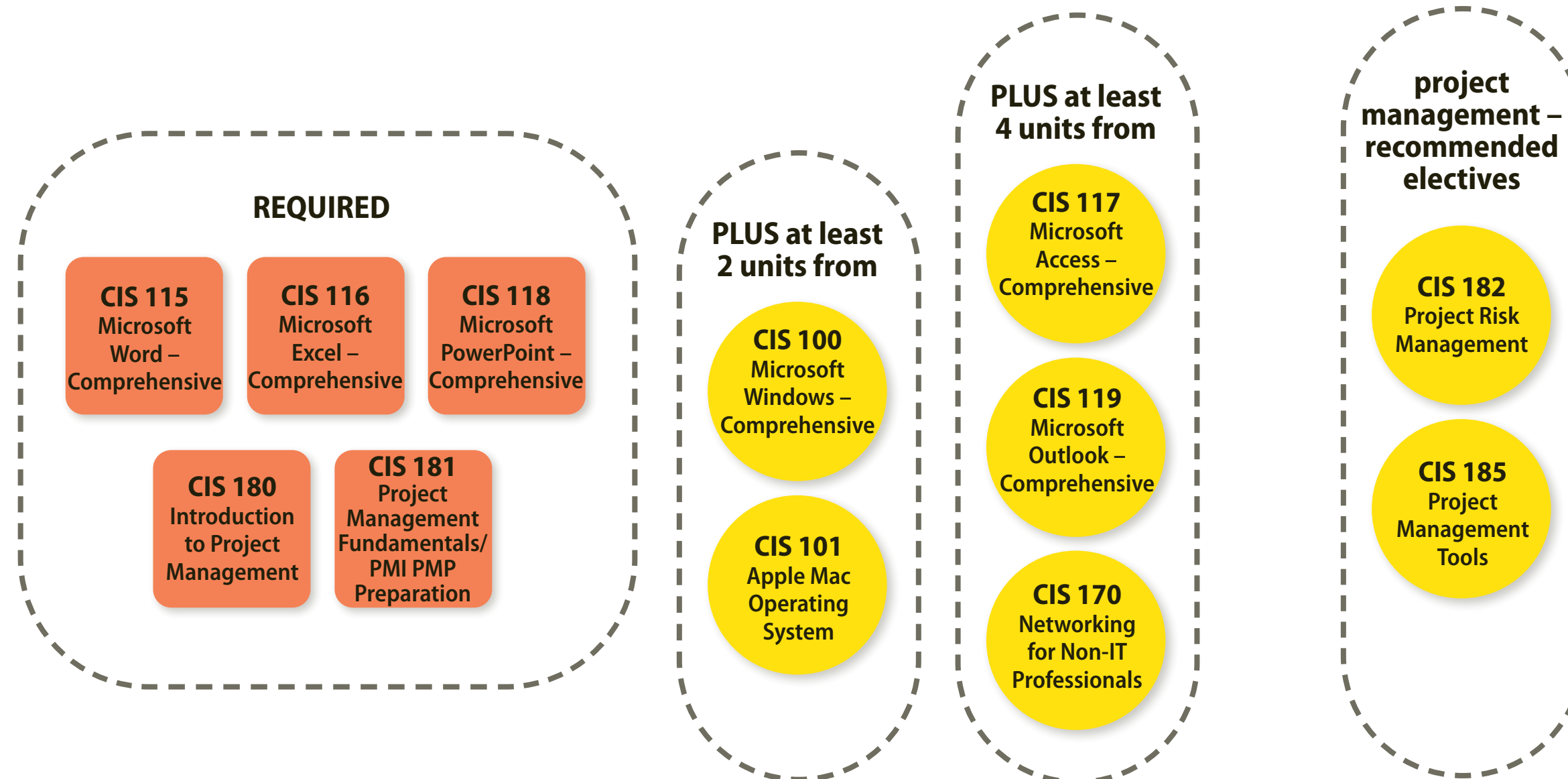
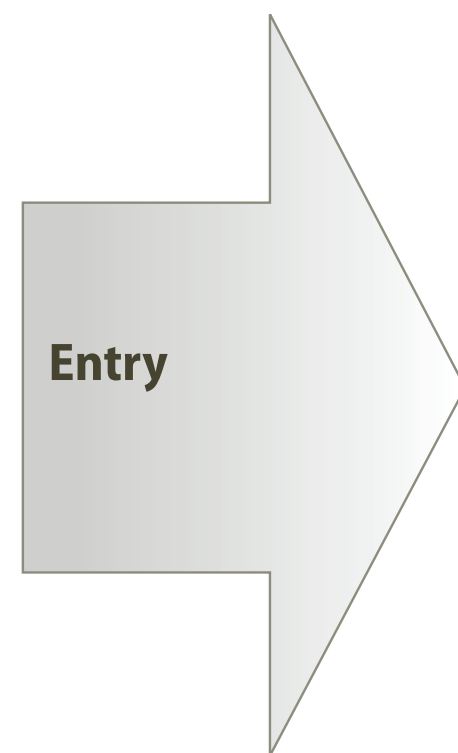

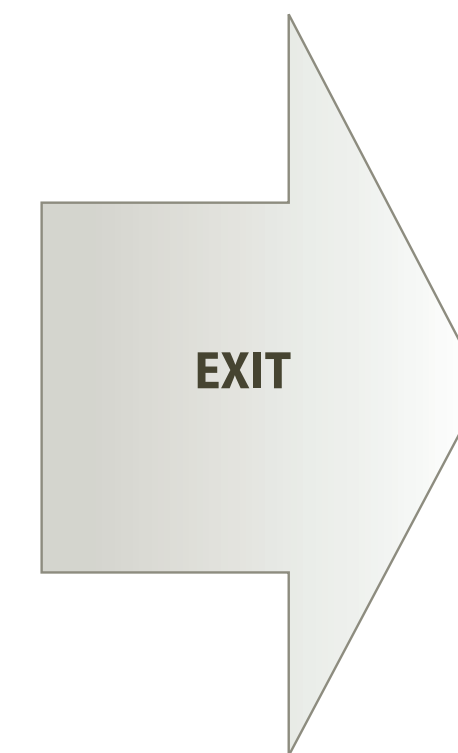
PROGRAM LEARNING OUTCOMES

3. Apply the principles of the Project Management Institute (PMI) processes of project management.

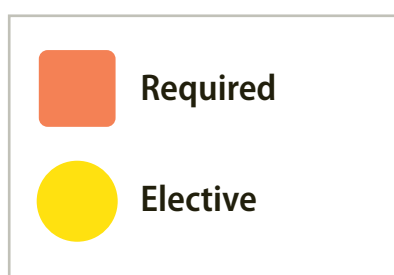
