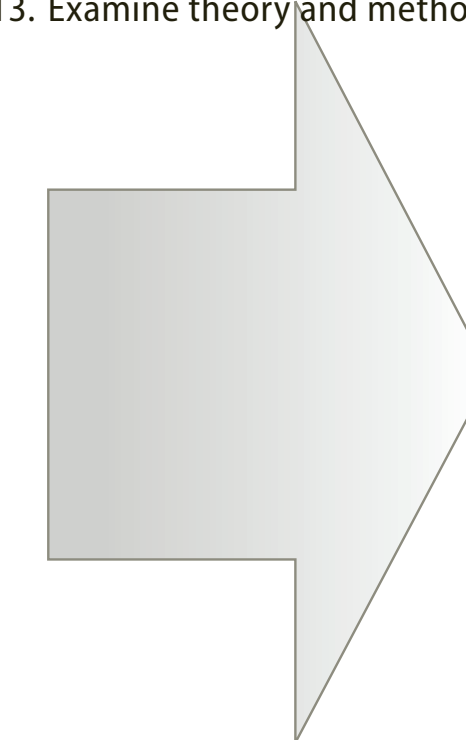
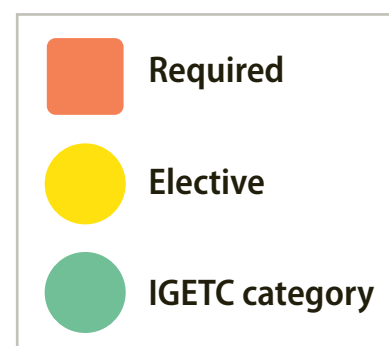
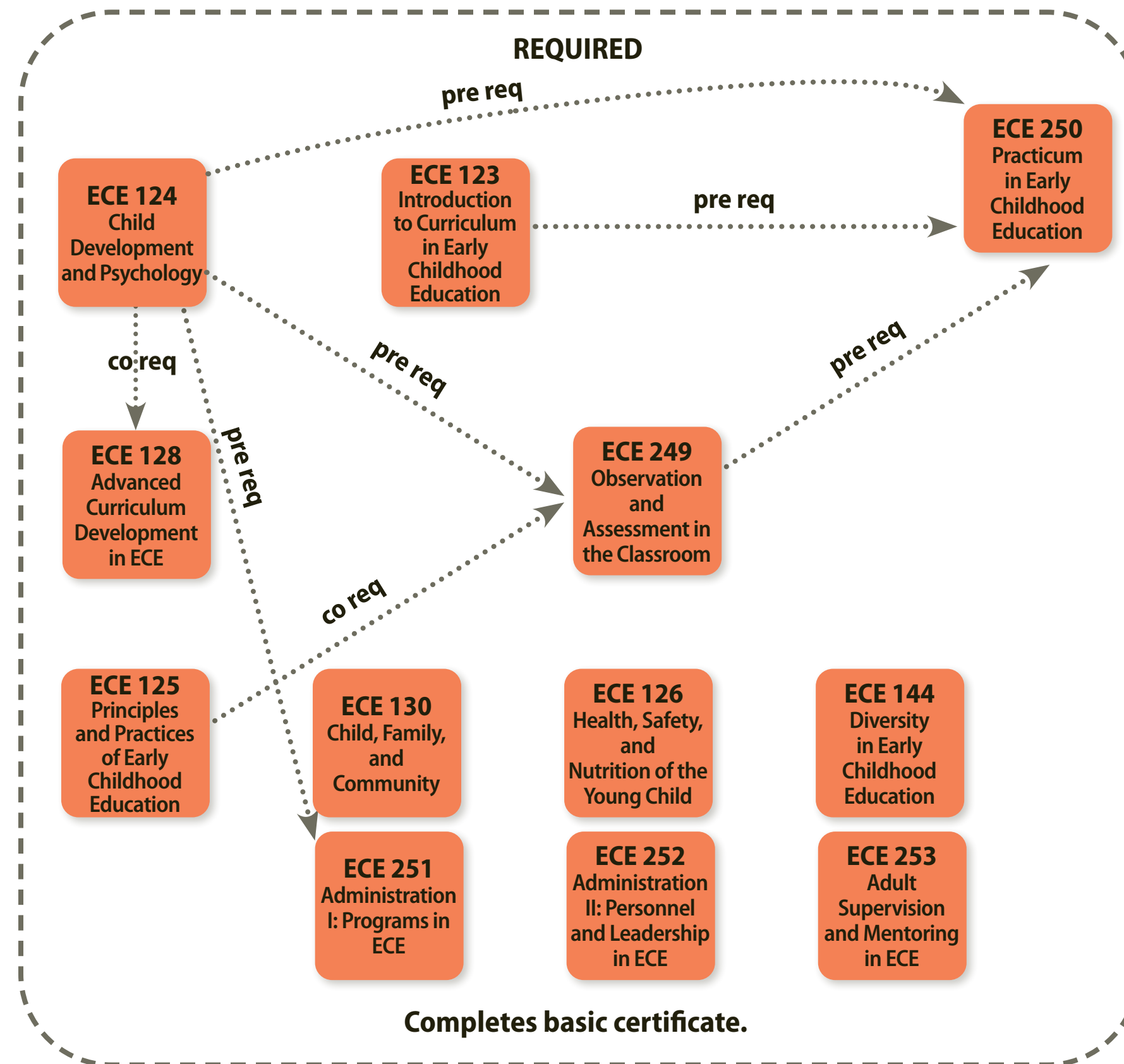
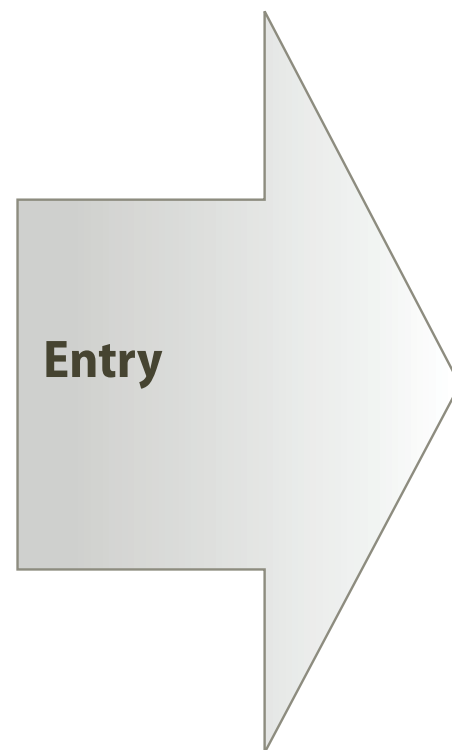


Early Childhood Education Certificate of Achievement–Site Supervisor
