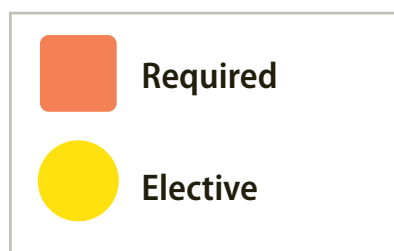
Students completing this program will be able to
