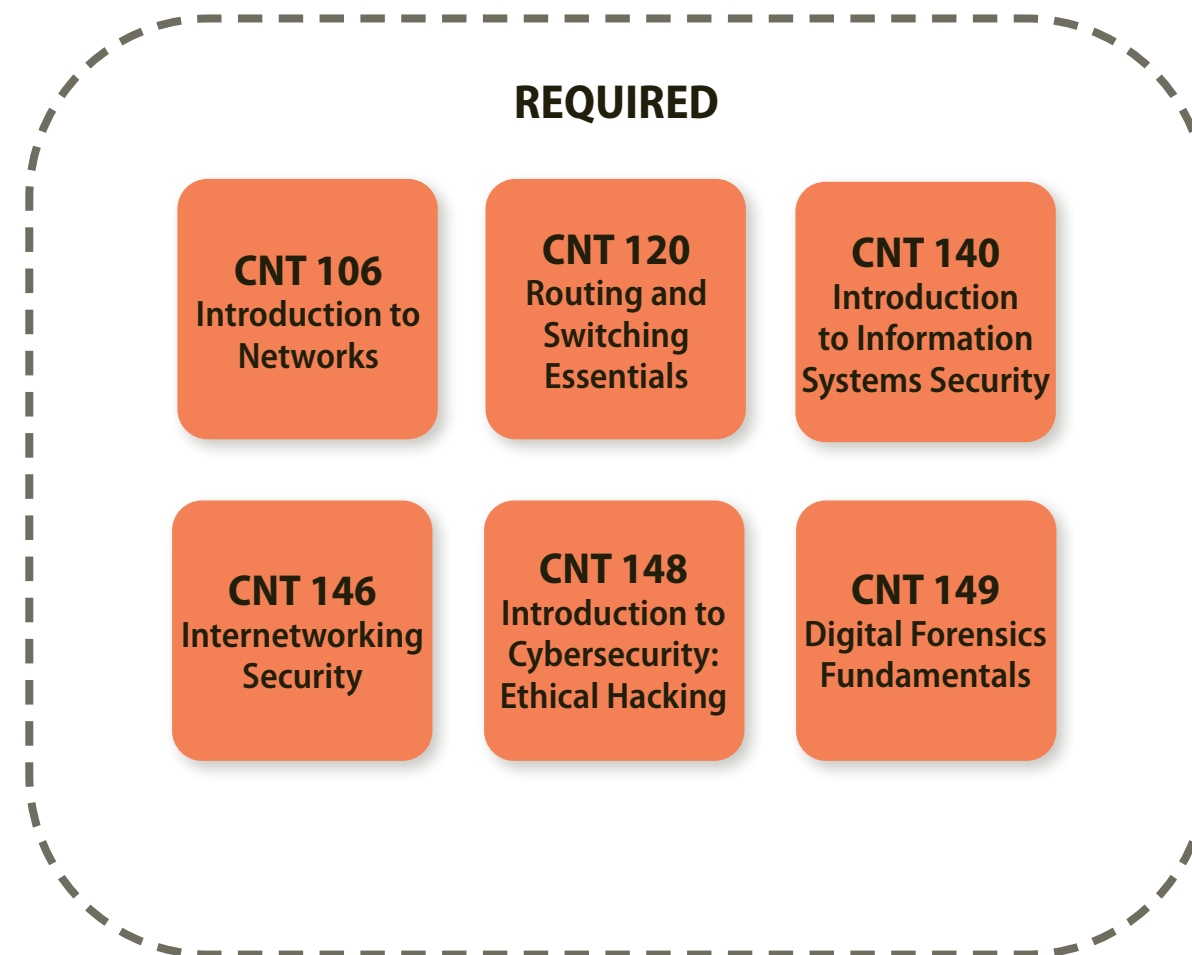
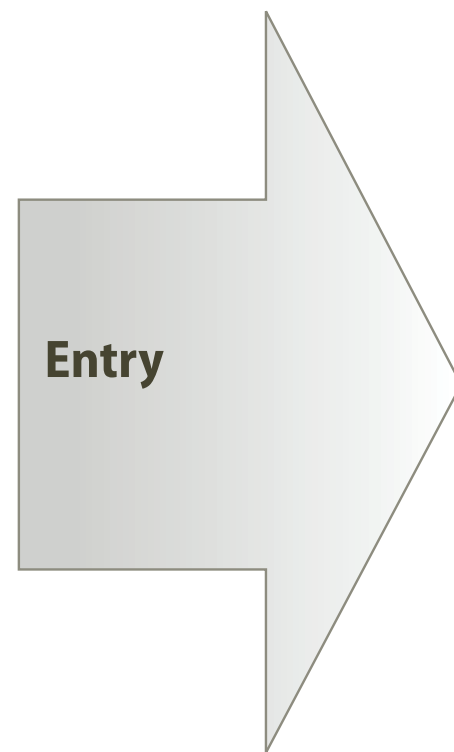


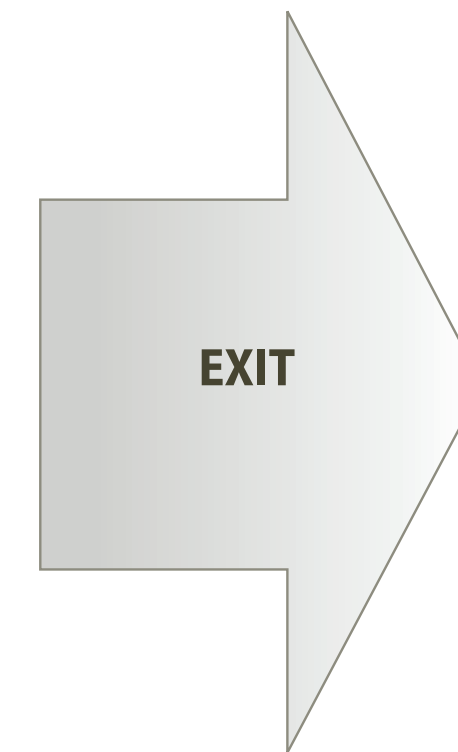

Students completing the program will be able to:

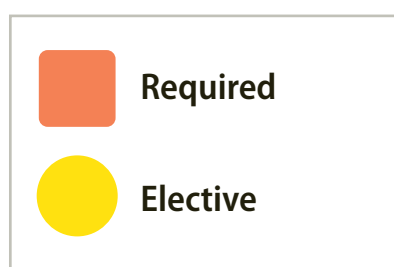
1. Identify computer components to make informed decisions when purchasing computer hardware and software.
