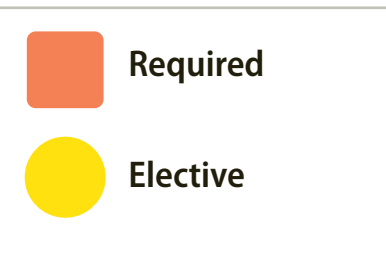
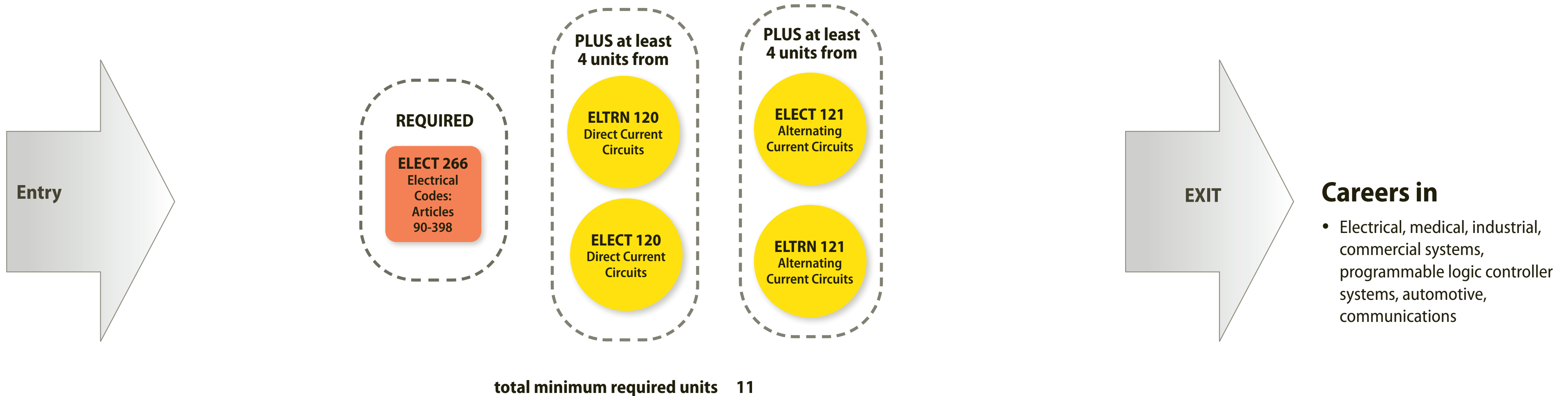


Electrical / Electronics Technology Certificate of Accomplishment
