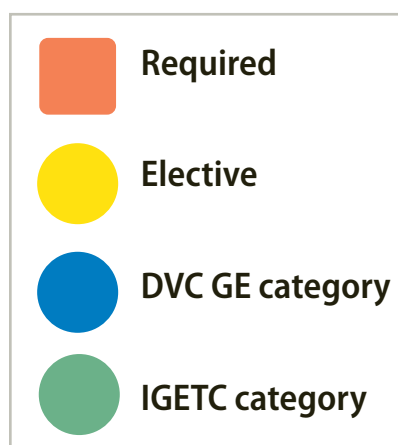


PROGRAM LEARNING OUTCOMES
