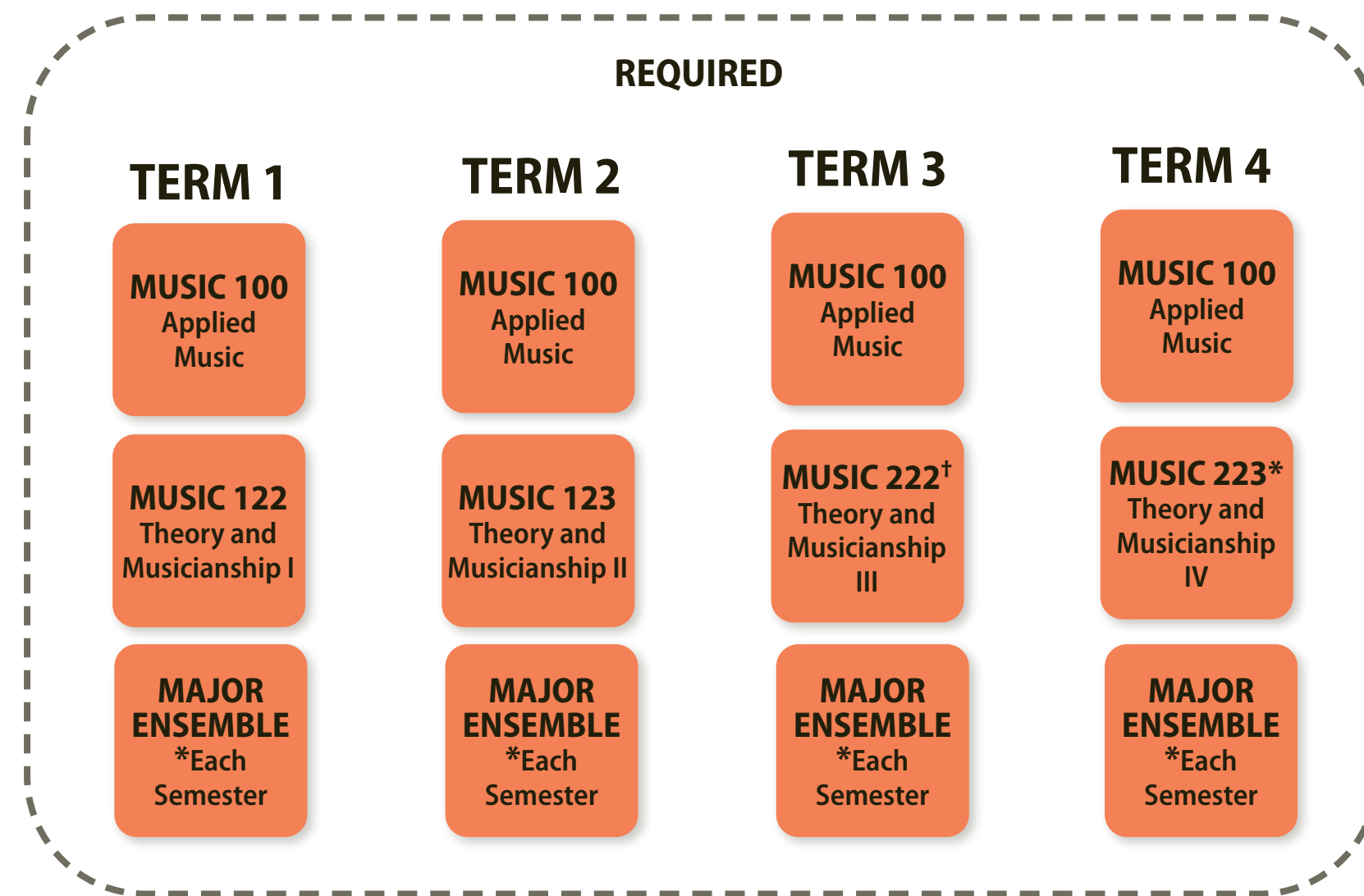
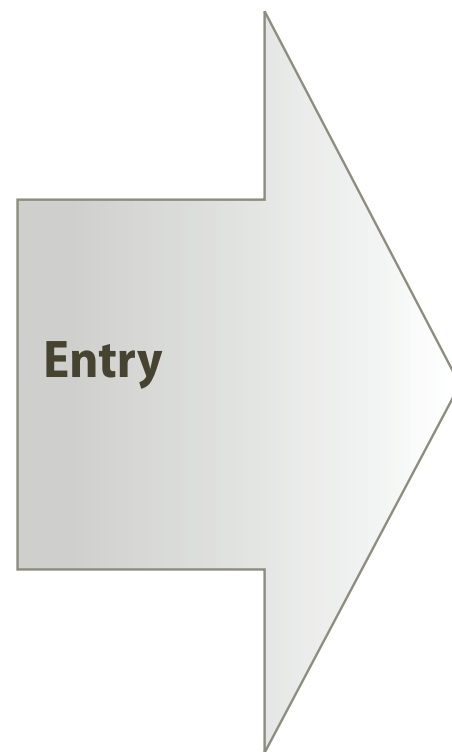

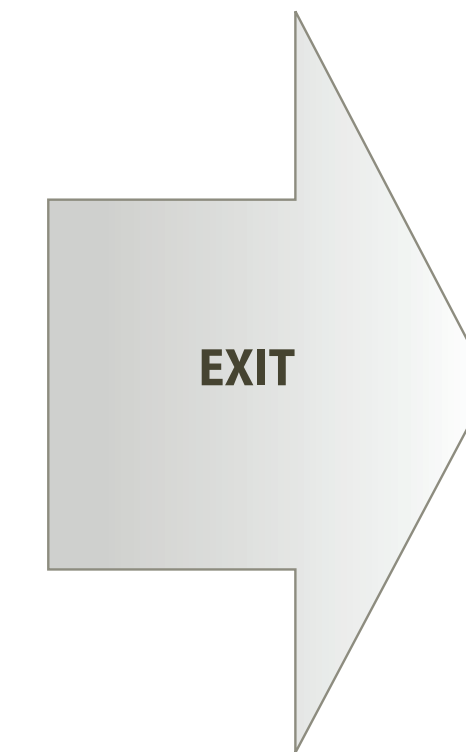
1. Perform music with technical facility and artistry on his/her voice or choice of instrument as a soloist and as a member of an ensemble.

One music is taken each semester in conjunction with MUS 100 and Music Theory.**

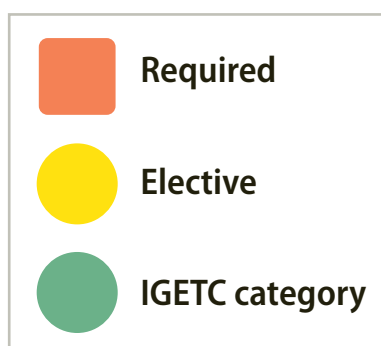
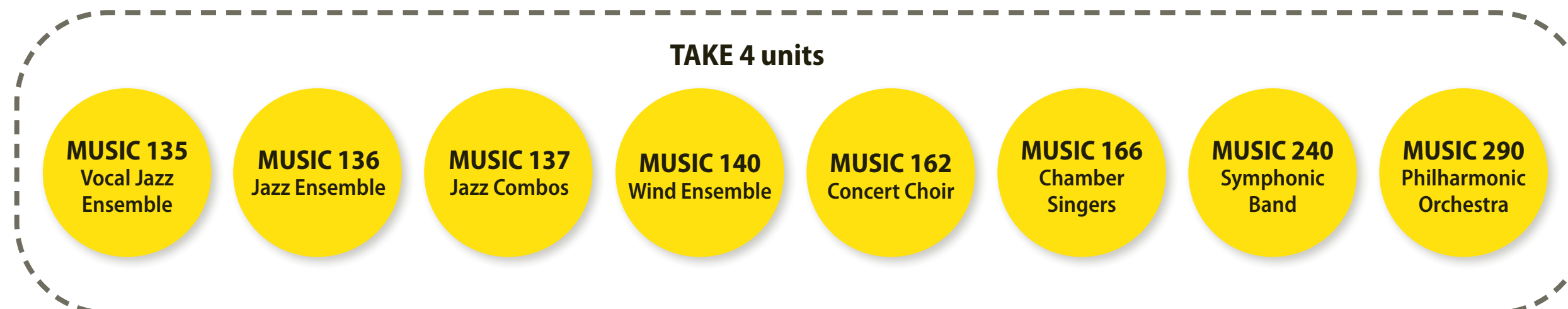
