- April 1** AA/AS degree or certificate filing period begins through July 15.
- April 8** Registration by appointment begins for CalWorks, EOPS, DSS, Foster Youth, and eligible veterans - online registration only.*
- April 10** Registration by appointment begins for continuing students (requested in summer 2018, fall 2018, or spring 2019), online only. Check InSite for your specific appointment day and time.*
- April 17** Registration begins for new matriculated and returning students online only.*
Returning students who missed more than one year need to reapply.
- May 6** Registration by appointment begins for new non-matriculated students, online only.*
- May 27** **Holiday - Memorial Day - college closed**
- May 28** **Three-week summer session begins (May 28 - June 13)**
- May 28** **Nine-week summer session begins (May 28 - July 25)**
- May 29** Begin new and returning special admit/concurrent high school students registration grades 11 and 12.
- May 30** Open walk-in registration for all students
- June 17** **Six-week summer session begins (June 17 - July 25)**
- June 17** Late registration - space available basis. Use online registration with late authorization, or in-person with signature of instructor. **
- July 4** **Holiday (observed) - Independence Day - college closed**
- July 15** Deadline to file AA/AS degree or certificate
- July 25** Last day of six and nine-week summer sessions
- August 26** **Fall classes begin**



Final exams: are scheduled by the instructors and are generally held on the last day of instruction.

Registration for classes after the course begins is on a space-available basis and will require a late add code or instructor signature. Students may use a late add code to register online. Students must register at the admissions counter with an instructor signature. InSite registration is available daily up to midnight the day before the class section begins.

* Online registration is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Students may register anytime on or after their appointment date and time up until midnight the day before the class section begins.

** Summer term class add/drop, refund, and pass/no-pass dates are calculated individually by class based on the specific number of meeting days. The add/drop and refund dates are listed on the class roster. Check with the instructor. You may also go to InSite, registration, to "My Class Schedule" for drop and refund dates.

Reminder: To receive a refund for a summer class, students must drop the class within 10 percent of the total meetings, which in most cases, during the summer, is the first class meeting.
