

**PETITION FOR AA/AS DEGREE**

1. Official transcripts and test scores used towards degree requirements must be on file, or provided at the time of submission.
2. Diplomas are mailed out up to **8 weeks** after grades are submitted at the close of each semester.
3. At least 12 units must be completed at DVC.
4. One commencement ceremony is held per academic year in May, invitations will be sent from the Office of the President.
5. Adhere to the degree filing period, which is published in the schedule calendar and online.
6. If you prefer a different name on your diploma than what is on your record, submit a Data Change form, with proof of legal name, to A&R.
