

Preparing for Transfer Day

1. Go to the dvc.edu/transfer/day website and look at the list of universities/colleges attending.
2. Make a list of the universities/colleges you would like to speak with and are interested in, so you have a plan.
 - a. Make sure to budget time for each college rep, and to allow extra time for the “popular” schools.
 - b. Broaden your horizons and approach and talk to schools you’ve never thought about. You never know if it ends up being “the one” school you’ve been looking for!
 - c. With private schools, ask if they have need-based or merit-based scholarships. They might end up being more affordable than you think.
3. Bring a list of specific questions you have regarding the school to ask the representative so you don’t forget.
4. Bring a notepad to write down answers.
5. Ask for the college representative’s contact information in case you have follow-up questions later on.
