<p>ADDITIONAL INFO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ideally, complete required courses for either system early in your transfer preparation. Not doing so may cause a delay in transfer. Many CSU campuses require that the “Golden Four” be completed by the end of Spring prior to Fall transfer or by the end of Summer prior to Winter/Spring transfer. All UC campuses require completion of required courses by the end of Spring prior to Fall transfer. In addition to the courses on this sheet, <i>most</i> CSU/UC campuses require specific <i>major</i> preparation courses be completed prior to transfer. <i>Please see your counselor and www.assist.org for details.</i>
