

How Do I Complete the Multiple Measures Assessment Program? (MMAAP)

The Multiple Measures Assessment Program allows you to receive a placement for English or English as a Second Language (ESL) and Math, by using your high school transcript.

You still have the option to take the in-person, computer based assessment in addition to completing MMAAP, and we will honor the highest placement. Please visit <https://www.dvc.edu/enrollment/assessment/schedule.html> to schedule an assessment. To complete MMAAP, have your final, unofficial high school transcript ready, and your InSite username and password.

1. Head to www.dvc.edu/assessment. MMAAP has two options— one for graduating high school seniors, and another for anyone who has graduated within the past 10 years.
2. Click the appropriate tab for whichever graduating class you belong to, and then click the link for “Enter Multiple Measures Transcript Information”. Log in with your InSite username and password.
3. To begin, you will first need to select between English and English as a Second Language (ESL).
4. You will need to enter information for English. Begin with entering EAP/CAASPP information if you have it.
5. Enter information for the English or ESL class that is specified.
6. Enter your Unweighted High School GPA (this may appear on your transcript).
7. You will see a summary of your English entries. Check your information is correct, and click to confirm.

8. Next, you will repeat the same steps as above, but for Math.

9. Your Unweighted High School GPA will be greyed out, as you already entered this information in step 6.

10. Check that the information you entered for Math is correct.

11. You will see a summary of your placements for English and Math. You should print the results.

12. To complete your MMAAP, email a PDF of your transcripts to DVCMMAP@dvc.edu.

You can also hand them in to Admissions and Records, as long as you write "MMAAP" and your student ID number on the transcript when submitting it.

13. Check the Recommended Next Steps for information on what to do next. For first-time college students and graduating high school seniors, you should proceed to register for Counseling 095. Students transferring from another college, or who are returning to DVC should see an academic counselor.
