Maintaining Your F-1 Status

- Must be enrolled in 12 units in fall and spring and maintain at least a 2.0 GPA
- Only 1 online or evening class per 12 units
- Notify ISAS of address change within 10 days
- Must get approval to go below 12 units before dropping classes
- Must get approval for any kind of employment
- Ask an advisor at ISAS if you have any questions about your F-1 status

Important Dates: Spring 2014

***Check "My Class Schedule" in Web Advisor for your class drop deadlines.**

1/20: Holiday, college closed

1/24: Last day to add a full-term class. Last day to drop a full-term class, in person, and be eligible for a refund of fees.

1/26: Last day to drop a full-term class, online, and be eligible for a refund of fees

1/27: Mandatory health insurance fee due

1/31: Last day to drop a full-term class, in person, without a "W" appearing on transcript

2/2: Last day to drop a full-term class, online, without a "W" appearing on transcript

2/7: Last day to request P/NP option for full-term class



International Student Health Insurance

The mandatory health insurance fee of \$511 is due on Friday, January 27.

You can pay online through Web Advisor or at the Cashier's Office on the first floor of the Student Services Center.

Within the first two weeks of school, you will receive an email from the insurance company so that you can create an account and print out your insurance card.
