Step 1: Select a Course

Select a course. Meet with the appropriate high school staff member (e.g. counselor, college and career advisor, etc.) to choose a class that is appropriate for you. (Example: ENGL-C1000). DVC staff cannot help you choose classes.

Step 2: Apply to DVC

Your application will take 24 hours to process. Once processed, you will receive an email with your InSite username, password, and your DVC ID number. InSite is the name of the DVC Portal.

Step 3: Check for Prerequisite Requirements

If the class you're trying to take has a **prerequisite**, you'll need to show that you've already completed that requirement. To do this, fill out the **Prerequisite Equivalency Form** and upload a copy of your **unofficial high school transcript**.

Step 4: Complete the Special Admissions Form





Log into Insite

If you want to take college classes while you're still in high school, you'll need to submit a Special Admissions Form through your InSite account. This form is emailed to a parent/guardian **AND** a high school designee for their approval. To complete the form, log into Insite and select the "DVC Student Forms" tile. In the drop-down menu, select "Special Admissions Form."

To complete the form, you will need:

- Your parent or legal guardian's email address
- Your high school principal's email address (or their designee's, such as your counselor)
- The course name and course number for the class you want to take (Example: COMM-120)

Step 5: Get Approval from Admissions & Records



After your special admissions form has been processed, you will receive an email from InSite informing you that you can register on your assigned registration date. If you are denied, you **MUST** contact admissions. Approval of this form does not guarantee you a seat in classes.





Step 6: Register for Classes

Classes fill up, so be sure to register on your registration date.
