



Step 1: Apply to DVC

After applying, you will receive an email from InSite within one to two days at the email address you used to create your CCCApply account. Make sure to check your spam or junk folder in case the message is filtered there.

If you do not receive your login credentials, you will need to email admissions@dvc.edu (Admissions & Records). In your email, include a picture of your photo ID, a picture of your ID.me completion screen showing your verified status, your application confirmation number, your CCCID number, and the phone number you used in your application.

Once processed, you'll get your InSite username, DVC ID, and a temporary password: Welcome2DVC[last four digits of your phone number]. InSite is your student portal-check your InSite email regularly for all college communications.

The approximate time to complete this step is 30 minutes.

Step 2: Apply for Financial Aid

Paying for college can be easier than you think! All DVC students are encouraged to apply for financial aid—you might be eligible for more than you expect.

- If you are a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen, fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- If you are undocumented and qualify for AB 540, complete the California Dream Act Application (CADAA).

Apply as early as possible-processing can take time, and early applicants may qualify for more support.

Also, don't forget to look into scholarships, grants, and student discounts—there are lots of ways to save as a college student!
