





# Assessments

Assessments are valuable tools that help students better understand themselves and make informed decisions about their future. They serve as a starting point for exploring majors and career paths by offering personalized insights based on interests, strengths, values, and skills.

- **Self-Discovery**
  - Assessments encourage students to reflect on their personalities, preferences, and abilities. This self-awareness is essential for choosing a career or major that aligns with who they are and what they enjoy.
- **Connecting Interests to Real-World Careers**
  - Tools like interest inventories or skills assessments link personal traits to actual jobs and academic programs. This helps students see how their passions and talents can be applied in the workforce.
- **Saving Time and Resources**
  - By helping students choose a major or career direction early, assessments can reduce the likelihood of switching majors multiple times, saving both time and tuition costs.
- **Providing a Roadmap**
  - Assessments often offer suggested majors, sample careers, salary information, and job outlooks, giving students a practical roadmap to follow.



# Career Coach

Career Coach platform offered by Diablo Valley College (DVC). This is a free, web-based tool designed to help students and job seekers explore career options, understand local job markets, and align their skills and interests with potential career paths.

- **Career Exploration:** Discover occupations that match your interests or existing skills.
- **Labor Market Insights:** Access up-to-date data on local wages, job demand, and employment trends.
- **Educational Pathways:** Find programs and courses at DVC that align with your chosen career.



# TRANSFER GUARANTEE PROGRAMS

**UC TAG-** It's a program that guarantees eligible California community college students admission to one of six participating UC campuses—as long as they meet specific requirements.

**TSP** (Transfer Success Pathways)- guarantees admission to any of the CSU's 22 universities. Available degree programs may vary by each university.

# TRANSFER GUARANTEE PROGRAMS



## UNITS

- 30 Transferable units completed at the time of TAG application.
- 60 Transferable Unit completed by SPRING 20XX.
- No more than 19 UNITS in the Spring 20XX to achieve the 60 Transferable Units.
- DO NOT EXCEED 80 Units (excluding students with only CCC Coursework).

## ENGLISH (UC-E) & MATH (UC-M)

- Completion of UC-E (English) by Fall 20XX.
- Completion of UC-M (Math) by Fall 20XX.

## GPA

- Student meets GPA Requirement set by the Campus.

## GENERAL EDUCATION

Complete 7-Course Pattern by Spring 20XX

- Two transferable courses in English composition.
  - One transferable course in mathematical concepts and quantitative reasoning.
- Four transferable college courses chosen from at least two of the following subject areas:
- arts and humanities
  - social and behavioral sciences
  - physical and biological sciences

## MAJOR PREP

- Student complete major prep courses for selective/impacted majors.
- Student visit the specific campus TAG website to read all details about major requirements.
- Student meet major GPA set by the campus.

## TRANSFER ACADEMIC UPDATE

- Student must complete a Transfer Academic Update by Jan 31 20XX.

## YOUR TRANSFER SUCCESS PATHWAY

### 01

#### CREATE A CSU TRANSFER PLANNER ACCOUNT.

The CSU Transfer Planner portal makes it easy to check your eligibility during the agreement cycle. You can also explore CSU campuses and degree programs, finalize your agreement with one of our 22 universities\* and track coursework at your community college. If you've applied to the CSU in the past through Cal State Apply, you have a CAS ID, which you can link to your CSU Transfer Planner account.

### 02

#### FIND YOUR RIGHT FIT.

Now you're ready to look for the place and the program that's best for you: Explore any or all of the CSU's 22 universities ([www.calstate.edu/campusmatch](http://www.calstate.edu/campusmatch)) and more than 4,000 degree programs ([www.calstate.edu/degrees](http://www.calstate.edu/degrees)) to find the right fit. If you applied to a specific campus before, this is your opportunity to return on your path.

Once you've chosen a university and a major, be sure to review the degree program transfer requirements, too; you'll find these in the CSU Transfer Planner. Each program outlines required GPAs, minimum grades for prerequisites, and any additional admission criteria.

### 03

#### SIGN AN AGREEMENT WITH YOUR CHOSEN CSU.

Now you're ready to enroll in the Transfer Success Pathway program through the CSU Transfer Planner. As a Transfer Success Pathway student, you're guaranteed admission to your chosen university for a future term! (You can only have one agreement, though you are able to cancel the agreement through the CSU Transfer Planner if your plans change.)

### 04

#### ACCESS CSU SERVICES.

In addition to the services you receive from your community college, as a student in the Transfer Success Pathway program you can get support and answers to your questions—including pre-admission advising—through your CSU.
